

## **ADVANCE NOTICE OF MAJOR RESURFACING WORKS**

### **A404 LONDON ROAD/BATCHWORTH HEATH HILL, RICKMANSWORTH**

#### **INFORMATION BULLETIN No.1**

**Issued on 5 August 2004**

As part of Hertfordshire County Council's programme for maintenance of the strategic road network the A404 London Road/Batchworth Heath Hill is to be reconstructed and re-surfaced between its junctions with Moor Lane and Batchworth Lane. The work will commence on Tuesday 31st August 2004 and will be completed in 5 weeks, weather permitting.

The work will involve the replacement of worn out road, minor kerb repairs, ironwork replacement, maintenance to the drainage system and anti-skid surfacing.

To minimise delay and inconvenience and to provide a safe working environment for the general public and workforce A404 London Road/Batchworth Heath Hill will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the works. Access to residential and business premises will be maintained, although some degree of disruption and delay can be expected. Works will be carried out 7 days a week between the hours of 7am to 7pm.

In addition it will be necessary to close White Hill at its junction with Batchworth Hill when works are in progress between White Hill and Batchworth Lane.

When the closures are in place temporary diversion routes will be provided as described below.

**A404 London Road:** via A4145 Moor Lane/Tolpits Lane/Hagden Lane,  
A4178 Wiggshall Road A4125 Eastbury Road/Hampermill Lane/Sandy Lane/  
Watford Road/High Street, A404 Rickmansworth Road.

**White Hill:** via Woodcock Hill and Harefield Road.

No through traffic will be allowed to enter the road closure and no parking will be permitted on London Road. Properties within an area that is closed will be issued with a permit to display in their vehicles at controlled access points to ease entry into the road closure.

Unfortunately, due to the nature of these works it is inevitable that there will be some congestion, disruption and delays. Whilst every effort will be made to minimise these, all the parties involved apologise in advance for the inconvenience these works will cause. Your patience and co-operation will be greatly appreciated. Further details of the project will be provided through the press and another publicity bulletin closer to the start date.
